HYSBYSIAD O GYNNIG AD-DREFNU YSGOL DAN DDEDDF SAFONAU A THREFNIADAETH YSGOLION (CYMRU) 2013

Rhoddir rhybudd drwy hyn yn unol ag Adran 42 Deddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion 2013 a'r Cod Trefniadaeth Ysgolion bod Cyngor Sir Ddinbych, ar ôl ymgynghori â'r fath bersonau, yn cynnig newid Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn yn Ninbych er mwyn cynyddu capaciti o 116 i 220. Cynhelir yr ysgol gan Gyngor Sir Ddinbych ar hyn o bryd ac mae'n ysgol arbennig gyd-addysgol i ddisgyblion sydd â Chyflwr ar y Sbectrwm Awtistiaeth ac anawsterau dysgu cysylltiedig, o 3 i 19 oed.

Cynhaliodd y Cyngor gyfnod o ymgynghori cyn penderfynu cyhoeddi'r cynnig hwn. Cynigir gweithredu'r cynnig ar 28 Ebrill 2025 pan gynigir meddiannu adeilad ysgol newydd.

Nifer presennol y disgyblion yn yr ysgol yw 136. Capaciti disgyblion yr ysgol yw 116 a'r capaciti arfaethedig ar ôl gweithredu'r cynnig fydd 220.

Bydd drefniadau derbyn i Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn, yn parhau drwy'r Panel Derbyniadau.

Nid yw'r cynnig yma'n cynnwys y ddarpariaeth breswyl - Gerddi Glasfryn. Bydd y ddarpariaeth hon yn dal i fod ar gael i ddisgyblion Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn.

Bydd y trefniadau cludiant o'r cartref i'r ysgol ar gyfer disgyblion sydd eisoes yn Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn yn parhau yr un fath yn yr ysgol newydd arfaethedig yn unol â Pholisi Cludiant o'r Cartref i'r Ysgol y Cyngor fel y mae ar ddyddiad gweithredu'r cynnig.

O fewn cyfnod o 28 diwrnod o ddyddiad cyhoeddi'r cynnig, sef erbyn 5 Rhagfyr 2022 gall unrhyw un wrthwynebu'r cynigion.

 - iv) Safle preswyl - Gerddi Glasfryn, Nantglyn, LL16 4ST - Nid yw'r ddarpariaeth hon yn newid a bydd dal ar gael i ddisgyblion Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn.
2. Mae'r gweithrediad yn amodol ar gytuno ar safle, caniatâd cynllunio yn cael ei gymeradwyo, cyllid ar gael a bod yr adeilad newydd yn barod.
3. Nodwyd y rhesymeg dros y cynnig hwn mewn dogfen ymgynghori a ddosbarthwyd ym mis Mai 2022.
4. Mae copïau o'r ddogfen ymgynghori a Pholisi Cludiant o'r Cartref i'r Ysgol ar gael gan Foderneiddio Addysg yn y cyfeiriad a nodir yn yr Hysbysiad.

NOTICE OF SCHOOL REORGANISATION PROPOSAL UNDER THE SCHOOL STANDARDS AND ORGANISATION (WALES) ACT 2013

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 42 of the School Standards and Organisation Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Denbighshire County Council, having consulted such persons as required, proposes to alter Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn in Denbigh so that the capacity is increased from 116 to 220. The school is currently maintained by Denbighshire County Council and is a co-educational special school for pupils with Autism Spectrum Condition (ASC) and associated learning difficulties from the age of 3 to 19.

The Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. It is proposed to implement the proposal on 28th April 2025 when occupation of a new school building is proposed. The current number of pupils at the school is 136, the pupil capacity of the school is 116 and the proposed capacity once the proposal is implemented will be 220.

Admission arrangements to Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn will continue via the Admissions Panel.

This proposal does not include the residential provision- Gerddi Glasfryn. This provision will still be accessible to Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn pupils.

The home to school transport arrangements for pupils currently at Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn will remain the same at the proposed new school in accordance with the Council's Home to School Transport Policy as at the date of implementation of the proposal.

Within a period of 28 days of the date on which the proposal was published, that is to say by 5th December 2022 any person may object to the proposals.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This explanatory note does not form part of the Notice but is offered by way of explanation)

1. Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn is currently located at:
 - i) Primary site- Tyn Fron Road, Denbigh, LL16 3DP
 - ii) Secondary site- Park Street, Denbigh, LL16 3DR
 - iii) Secondary site (complex needs)- Ty'r Ysgol, Gwynfryn site, Denbigh, LL16 4ST
 - iv) Residential site- Gerddi Glasfryn, Nantglyn, Denbigh, LL16 4ST- This provision is not impacted by this proposal and will still be accessible to Ysgol Plas Brondyffryn pupils.
2. The implementation is subject to a site being agreed, planning consent being approved, funding being available and the new build being ready.
3. The rationale for this proposal was set out in a consultation document circulated in May 2022.
4. Copies of the consultation document and Home to School Transport Policy are available from Modernising Education at the address set out in the Notice.
5. This Notice marks the start of a 28-day objection period from **8th November 2022 to 5th December 2022** and sets out the address to which objections in writing may be submitted.
