COUNCIL TAX PROPERTY EXEMPTION FORM (ARMED FORCES ACCOMODATION {UK FORCES})

IN RESPECT OF:

This form will help the Council determine whether this property should be exempt from Council Tax. It will also assist the Council in determining from when, or up to, which date the exemption should apply.

Living accomodation for UK armed forces which is owned by the Secretary of State is exempt whether occupied or not. This includes barracks and other accomodation on military bases together with married quarters and any other dwellings, wherever located, provided the accomodation is held for the purposes of forces accomodation. A dwelling held for the purposes of Armed Forces accomodation but temporarily occupied by civilians would continue to be exempt, but a dwelling owned by the Ministry of Defence for occupation by civilians eg. the Territorial Army would not be exempt.
