

## Council Tax Exemption (Class X) / Reduction for Care Leavers

From the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019, care leavers are exempt from paying Council Tax. If a care leaver lives alone, or the property is wholly occupied by care leavers, a Council Tax exemption will apply up to the date they reach the age of 25.

If a care leaver lives with one or more adults, a Council Tax discount of 25% will apply.

To qualify for this exemption/discount the following conditions must be met:-

- The care leaver must be at least 18 years but not yet 25
- Is classed as a category 3 young person as defined by section 104 of the Social Services and Well-being (Wales) Act 2014
- Is no longer looked after by a local authority
